If a student does not follow the Code of Conduct, they will be sent to the Faith Formation Office. Final decisions regarding acceptable behavior or the consequences of it are the decision of the Faith Formation Director or staff member in charge. The second time a student is sent to the office, the parent will be notified to discuss the problem. Ongoing discipline problems may result in the dismissal from the program.
